

## Step-by-step plan – Create Studielink Account with DigiD

(Only for students with a Dutch home address)

### **WARNING: Do you have an existing account?**

If you already have an account on Studielink to which you log in with your email address and password, please do not log in with DigiD yet. This will create a duplicate account.

To start using your DigiD, log in to your account without your DigiD first. In your personal dashboard go to 'Details' and change your home address to your Dutch address. Studielink will match your account with the data from the municipal Personal Records Database (BRP, previously GBA). Within a few days you will receive a message in Studielink that states you can now log in with DigiD.

➔ **Step 1:** Go to [www.studielink.nl](http://www.studielink.nl), choose your preferred language in the upper right corner (Dutch, English or German) and click <**Log in with DigiD**>.

→ **Step 2:** Log in with your DigiD by using the DigiD app, SMS verification or by using your identity card. If you do not yet have a DigiD, you must first apply for one (via digid.nl).

→ **Step 4:** When you have entered and saved your contact details, you will receive an e-mail with an activation link. Go to your inbox and click the link in the email.

→ **Step 5:** After you have activated your account, you are rerouted to the homepage of Studielink. Click on <**Log in with DigiD**>. You will be asked to submit an enrolment application. *You cannot create an account without submitting an enrolment application.*

If you have previous education in the Netherlands it will be automatically loaded into your account. If there is no previous education known, you will be asked to fill this in.


